Between 82-96% of patients are treated free of cost at our Institute through various finance supporting schemes of Government and MCC(PGIOSR).

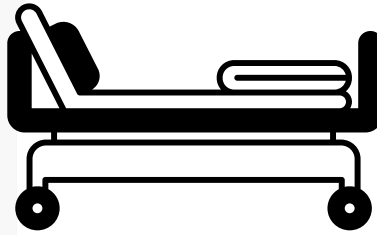
