PROGRESS OF AYUSH THROUGH THE YEARS

Kerala – the State that has been far ahead of other states in India in the field of public health for a long time, and the AYUSH sector has played a major role in this.

Developments worth over **Rs 1,500 crore** have been made in the AYUSH sector in the last three years.

This includes **116** newly created posts in the Ayurvedic treatment field and **40** posts of medical officers in the Homoeopathy Department.

AYUSH sector has opened with **1400 positions**, including Yoga instructors and GNM multipurpose workers, in **700 AYUSH Health and Wellness Centers**.

The construction of **40 new Homoeopathy dispensaries**, making Kerala a state with homoeopathy dispensaries in all local bodies.

Construction of **10 AYUSH Integrated Hospitals**

The **E-hospital system** implemented in the AYUSH sector

HEART project for various scientific research projects under the Department of Homoeopathy emphasizes the need of scientific studies.

The Ayurkarma project been implemented in **26** more Ayurvedic institutions to make Ayurvedic Panchakarma treatments accessible to more common people

The palliative care project in the AYUSH sector was also integrated with the comprehensive palliative care project, **ARIKE**.

The Kayalpa Award was launched with the aim of improving the quality of AYUSH treatment institutions and focusing on cleanliness and infection control

250 institutions attained **NABH recognition**
