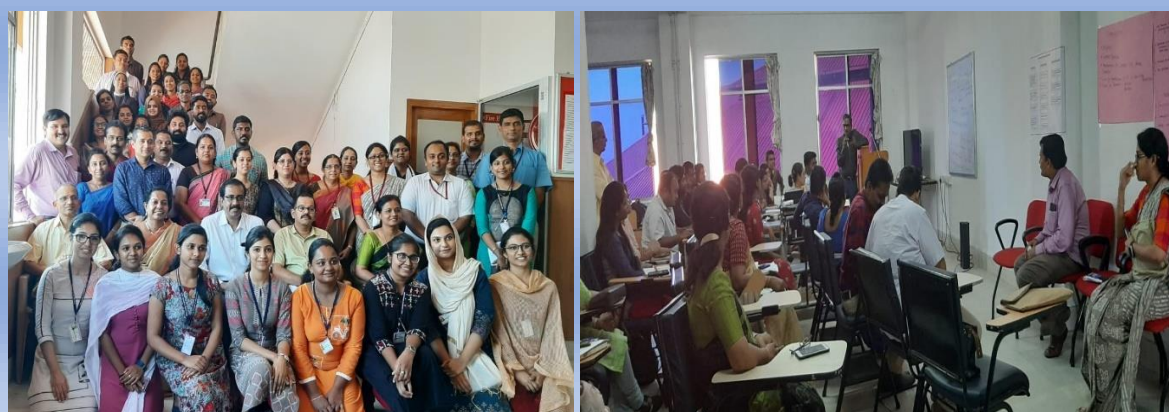

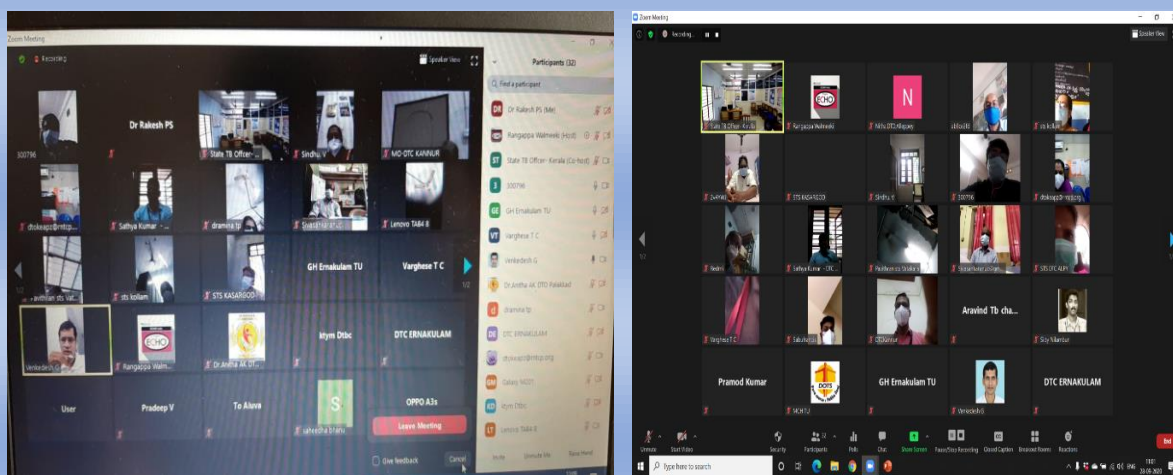


District TB Tele- Health Helpline numbers

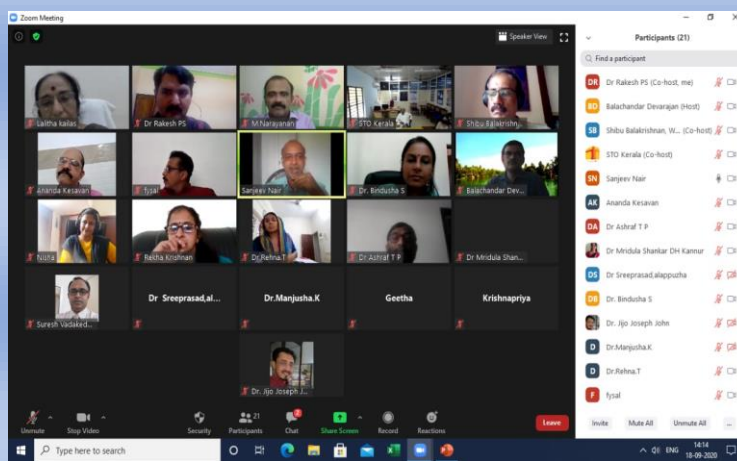
State TB Forum meeting on 28/09/2020

State Medical College NTEP Task Force Meeting held on 13th October 2020

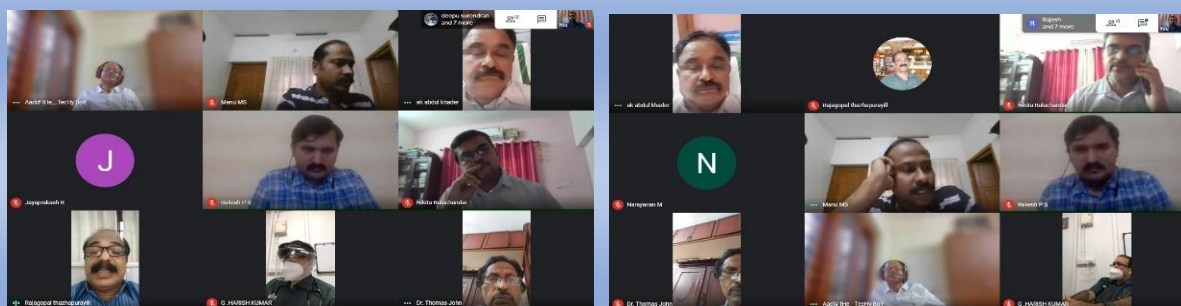

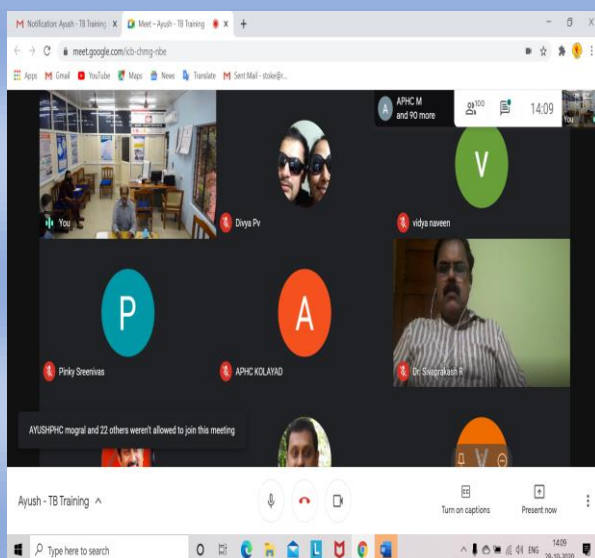

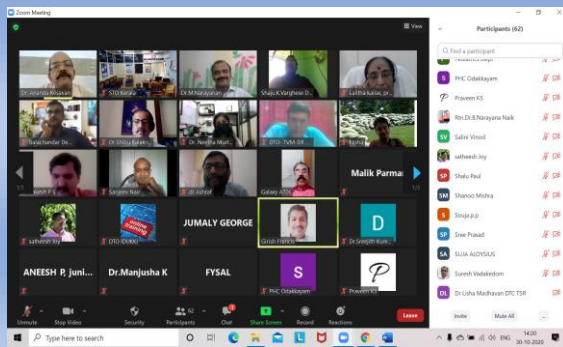
India has six recognized medicine systems in this category, namely Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Yoga, Naturopathy and Homoeopathy. This review was undertaken to evaluate the efficacy of different drug treatments based on Indian Systems of Traditional Medicines to the standard MDR-TB regimen. This review mainly focuses on the combinational approaches towards treatment protocols, prevention strategies, and management of tuberculosis in different established systems of medicine in India. The findings in this review have provided scientific support for anti-TB activity of different medicinal system of India via numerous underlying mechanisms.

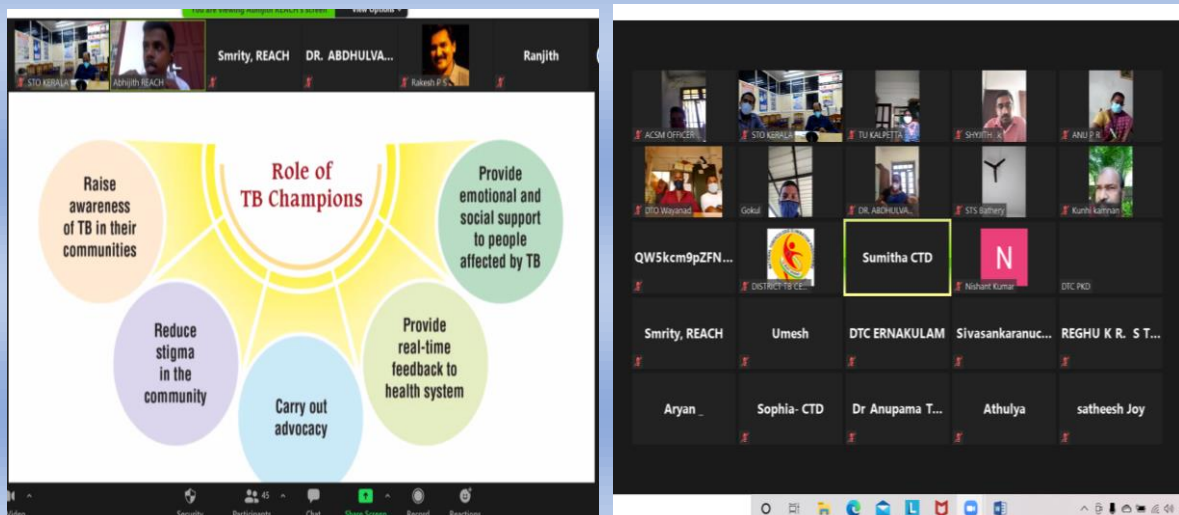
State level online training for private labs – NTEP 25 November 2020

Consortium of Private Labs for TB Elimination in Kerala met and they decided to scale up services immediately for offering upfront NAAT for TB diagnosis.



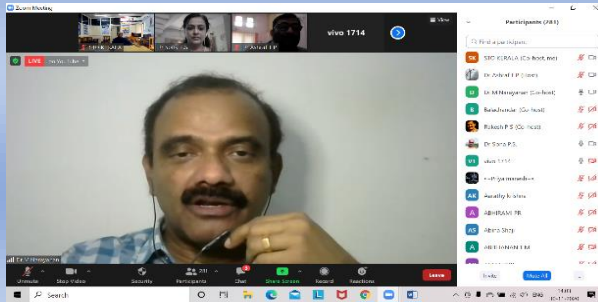
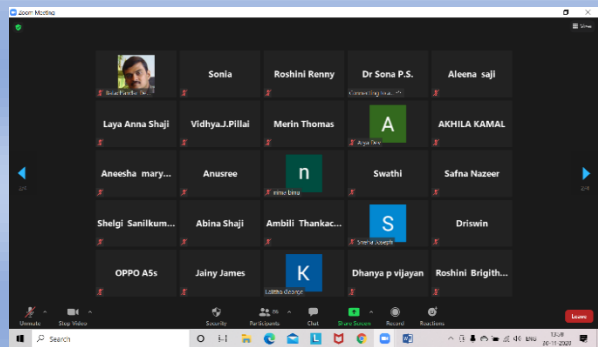
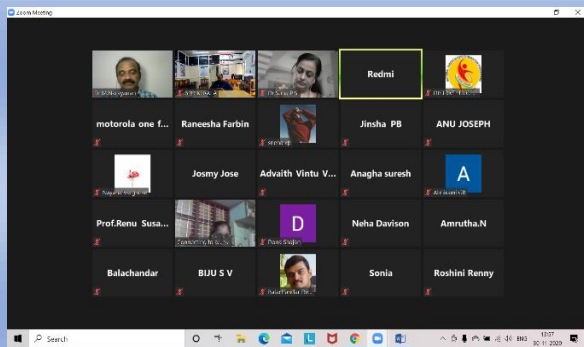
TB SURVIVORS MEETING ON 30TH NOVEMBER 2020

TB –HIV Coordination Activities

Co-ordinated efforts of National AIDS Control Organization and the National TB Elimination Program are essential to achieve goals of both these national programmes. State TB Cell are working on various activities for this, which includes



- Periodic review meetings with KSACS to strengthen the ongoing TB- HIV bi-directional screening, TB prophylaxis for all eligible PLHIV and TB management for all co-infected PLHIV.
- In collaboration with KSACS, as part of New India@75, TB awareness campaigns were conducted in schools and colleges' Red Ribbon Clubs in selected districts.
- State TB Cell has also extended its support to KSACS for “SUBHIKSHA Plus: - A program to intensify access to testing and treatment services among the incarcerated populations in all prisons and other closed settings with regard to HIV, TB, STI and Viral Hepatitis” to intensify TB testing and treatment services

STEPS (System for Eliminating TB in Private Sector).



STEPS is an initiative to increase TB Notification and follow-up in private sector. STEPS was officially launched on **10/02/2019** during State wise TB Coalition and Consortium ceremony. The Internal committee's to be formed in Private hospitals and other systems for TB Elimination in private sector will be named after STEPS. The concept of STEPS is to avoid stigma for notifying the disease in its presumptive stage itself. And all patients will receive the standards of TB care irrespective of their point of treatment. There are 328 STEPS Centre's are functioning In Kerala.

Service Delivery: Effective Implementation of Sample Transportation for Diagnosis and UDST

To ensure continuous TB diagnostic services, the state has established mechanisms for TB specimen collection and transportation from home / peripheral health institutions (PHIs) to the TB laboratories in all the districts. This includes diagnosis of TB among suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19. State has effectively implemented TB sample transportation Mechanism by utilizing the manpower and service of ASHAs and NGO's. The transporter assigned to the public and private health institutions for the collection purpose. Incentives for them were fixed depending upon the distance from collection centre to the respective NAAT sites and Sample carrying kits are provided for transportation of specimen and also ensures the timely dispatch of the lab test results on each visit to NAAT site.

Dedicated X ray facilities also have been identified for diagnosis of TB among the later, in all the districts.

There are District level clinical expert committees in every district to support the diagnostic process through tele / direct consultations as per requirement.
