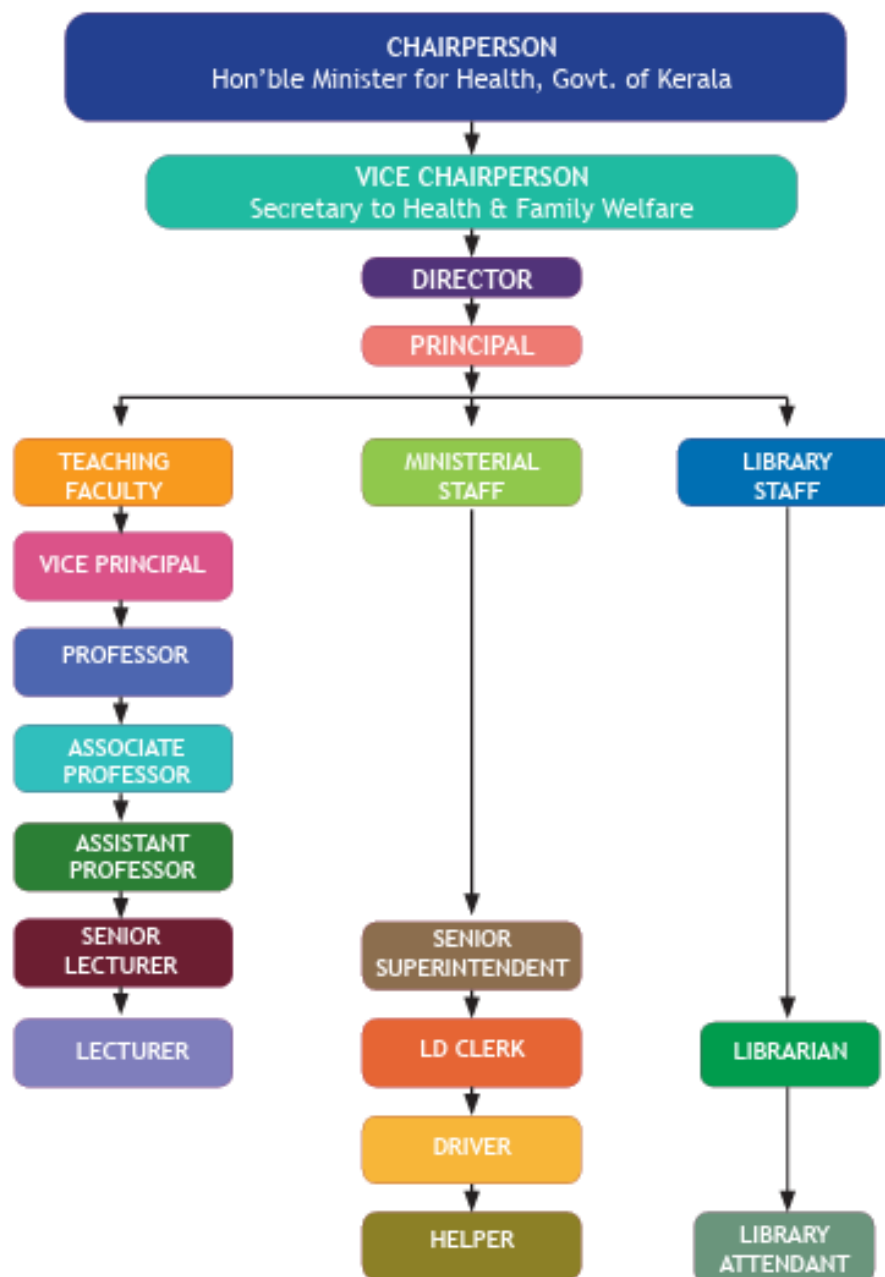

administrative system and centralized leadership the SI-MET Directorate ensures effective governance, accountability, and smooth functioning of all institutions under its purview.

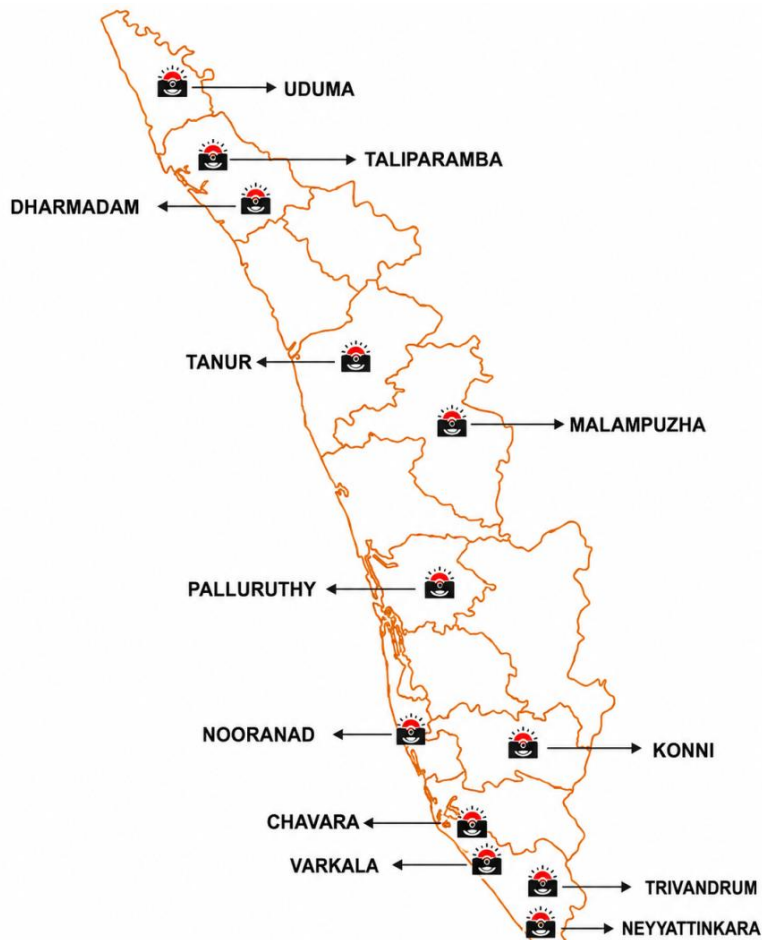

4.1 Courses and structure

SI-MET offers BSc Nursing course with 60 seats sanctioned per year. It also offers Post Basic BSc Nursing course at SI-MET Palluruthy with 30 seats sanctioned per year.

During this visit, they closely observed the healthcare system, nursing practices, patient safety measures, working conditions and professional standards followed at UKS, ensuring that the training and future placement environment for students would be safe, ethical and professionally enriching. The insights gained during this visit strengthened academic alignment and reinforced confidence in the collaboration. Subsequent activities such as orientation programmes, skill training by UKS representatives and the initiation of German language training supported the structured implementation of the programme. Overall, the initiative reflects SI-MET's commitment to guiding students towards a better professional environment through carefully planned international collaboration. 50 students of 5th semester of BSc Nursing from SI-MET College of Nursing Muttathara and SI-MET College of Nursing Neyyattinkara are selected for employment in Saarland University as part of the GSP programme.



Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training and demonstration are critically important for nursing students because they prepare future nurses to respond effectively to life-threatening emergencies. BLS training is being organized in all SI-MET institutions to ensure experiential learning among students, which reduces hesitation and panic in real emergencies, enabling students to act swiftly and decisively.

6.3 Funding and procurement overview

SI-MET is functioning as a self-financing institution NO PROFIT NO LOSS basis. The main source of income is fees from students. The financial structure and oversight of the Institute are governed by a systematic process of fund acquisition and internal budgeting. The primary sources of capital consist of grants from the Government of Kerala and various fees or rates levied from students and institutions.

To manage these resources, a dedicated Committee is responsible for framing an annual budget of estimated income and expenditure, which is then submitted to the Governing Body for formal adoption. Continuous accountability is maintained through annual audits conducted by auditors appointed specifically by the Governing Body.

The reporting and asset management protocols ensure transparency and strict adherence to government regulations. All audited statements and auditor observations must be presented during the Governing Body's annual meetings or at a subsequent meeting if the documents are not immediately ready. Additionally, the Governing Body is required to present the Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure account to the General Body at least once a year. Within six months of the financial year's close, a comprehensive report on the Institute's operations and a half-year audited statement must be submitted to the Government of Kerala. Furthermore, any assets acquired through government financial assistance must be recorded separately; these assets cannot be disposed of, encumbered, or repurposed without obtaining prior sanction from the Government.

6.4 Reporting and review mechanism

The administrative leadership of the Institute is structured into three primary roles, each with distinct mandates to ensure effective governance. The **Chairman** holds the highest authority, presiding over Governing Body meetings, providing general supervision of operations, and exercising all regulatory powers granted to the position. Supporting this role, the **Vice-Chairman** serves as the head of the Executive Committee and assumes the Chairman's presiding duties and conferred powers during their absence. The **Director** manages the daily functions of the Institute, handling administrative tasks such as issuing meeting notices, maintaining minutes, and signing official documents, while also overseeing financial matters like disbursements, receipts, and bank account operations. Furthermore, the Director is responsible for maintaining all records, performing duties assigned by the Governing Body, and delegating specific functions to other officers as necessary to maintain the proper and effective working of the Institute.
