ORDER

As per the Government Order read 1st above, Government have issued guidelines on the management of RSBY, CHIS and other Insurance Receipts in the Government Hospitals.

For the effective functioning of the Hospitals the following guidelines are included

1. There will be no limit for the purchase of consumables
2. If the intent of the Hospital for medicines is adequate for case load of the hospital, the institution is allowed to intent an additional intent of 25% to KMSCL for purchase of drugs. KMSCL shall allot the amount and recover the amount from RSBY funds. This allocation is in addition to other ceilings stipulated in the Government Order referred to above.

The Government Order referred above stands modified to the above extent only.
