ORDER

In the Guidelines specified under item (C) of the Government order read as first paper above, Government have earmarked 85% of the insurance amount coming in to the account as HMC/HDS share and the remaining 15% as the incentive share.

2. The High Powered Supervisory Council (HPSC) meeting held on 13.01.2010 has recommended Government to enhance the percentage of incentive share from the existing 15% to 25% . In the letter read as third paper above, Director of Health Services has also recommended the proposal.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to enhance the incentive share payable to the Medical Officers and hospital staff as 25%. The manner of distribution of the enhanced incentive shall be discussed and finalized separately. It is further ordered that Public Relations Officers in the Government hospitals will be given Rs.50/ for each RSBY/CHIS beneficiary availing treatment in Government hospitals subject to a maximum

of Rs.5000/- per month for an initial period of six months. This will be subject to review later.

4. The Government Order read as first paper above stands modified to the above extent.
