Daily Ebola bulletin of Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Kerala

A) Key Message to Keralites in Ebola affected countries and their relatives in Kerala

1. If you are experiencing any symptoms while travelling, inform the aircraft crew
2. Complete the Self Declaration Form provided by the airlines
3. The Self Declaration Form should be filled correctly, so that the danger to your life and that of your loved ones will be minimised.
4. Cooperate with the airport health team for screening of Ebola symptoms, so that you can be guided appropriately for expert care in designated facilities
5. If you had any contact with suspected or Ebola patients while in Africa, it should be informed to the Health team
6. If you are asymptomatic and have no contact with Ebola patients, you may be asked to stay at home for 21 days
7. If you experience any symptoms during this period, you can contact the District Surveillance Team or DISHA (1056) Helpline number for appropriate guidance.
