



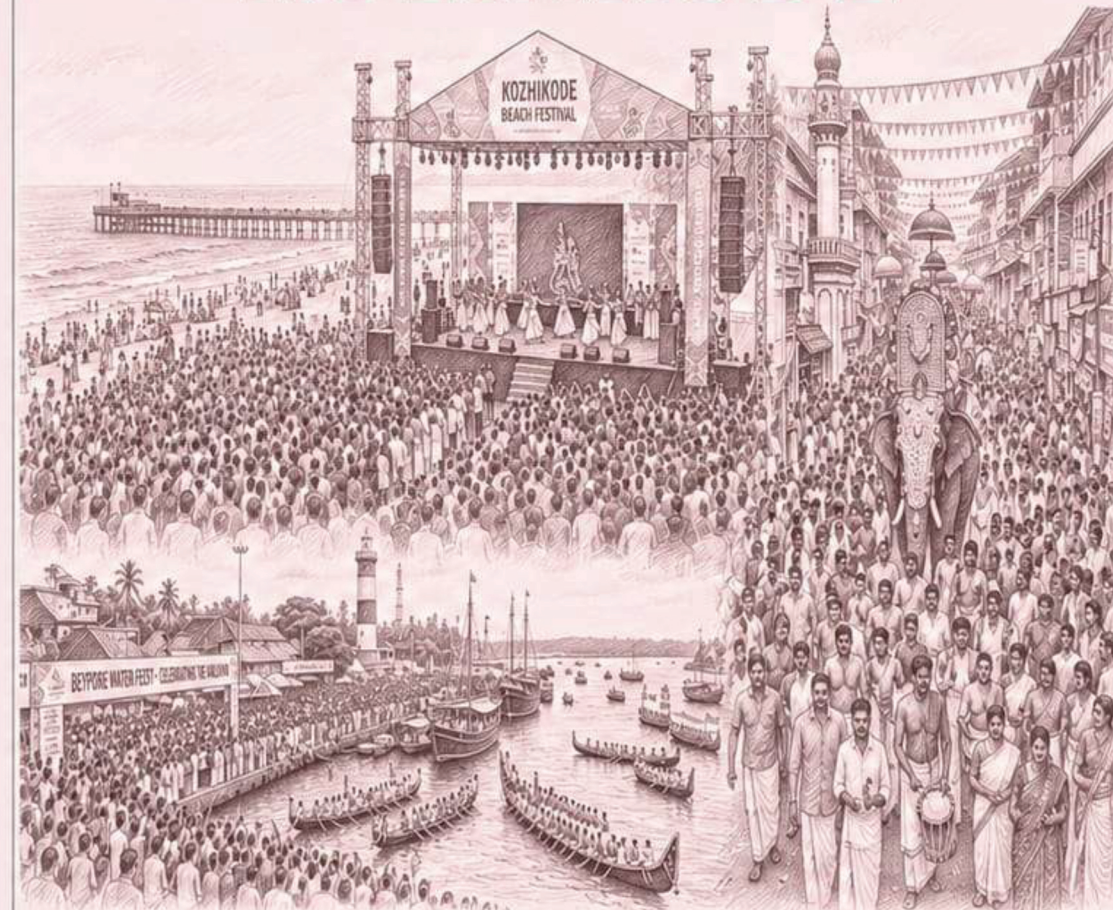

Foreword

Kerala has long stood as a model for responsive, resilient, and people-centred public health systems. Our collective experiences during public health emergencies, infectious disease outbreaks, natural disasters, and mass gathering events have repeatedly reaffirmed one fundamental truth, preparedness at the district level remains the cornerstone of an effective health security framework. It is in this context that the District Festival Preparedness Plan – Kerala assumes profound relevance and strategic importance.

Festivals in Kerala are not merely cultural celebrations; they represent large-scale social congregations involving dynamic population movement, heightened healthcare demands, increased risks of communicable disease transmission, trauma, crowd-related emergencies, environmental hazards, and public health vulnerabilities. A scientifically structured district-level preparedness mechanism therefore becomes indispensable to ensure timely prevention, coordinated response, efficient surveillance, emergency medical readiness, and continuity of essential healthcare services during such events.

This document has been conceived as a practical and operational extension of the State Pandemic Preparedness Framework and the Standard Treatment Guidelines developed by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Kerala. By contextualising preparedness into district-specific operational strategies, the document seeks to strengthen decentralised health governance, interdepartmental coordination, emergency response systems, surveillance architecture, risk communication pathways, referral mechanisms, and rapid mobilisation protocols across all districts of the State.

Thrissur district team prepared scientific Thrissur Pooram management Plan. They were asked to prepare a generic framework for preparing Festivals Management Plans. The framework was shared with the district teams and they worked on preparation of Festival Management Plans.

The preparation of this comprehensive framework reflects the spirit of collaborative public health leadership and multidisciplinary teamwork that defines Kerala's healthcare system. I place on record my sincere appreciation to all District Medical Officers (DMOs) for their committed contributions and field-level insights in shaping this important initiative. Preamble

Mass gatherings are integral to the cultural, religious, and social fabric of Kozhikode district, bringing together large populations for festivals, celebrations, and community events throughout the year. While these occasions strengthen social cohesion and cultural identity, they also pose significant public health challenges, including the risk of communicable disease transmission, injuries, environmental hazards, and strain on health systems. In recent years, experiences from outbreaks and emergencies have underscored the importance of structured preparedness and coordinated response mechanisms, particularly in densely attended events.

A systematic mapping of mass gathering events in the district has identified a total of 794 events annually, reflecting their high frequency and diversity. The temporal distribution demonstrates a clear seasonal trend, with the highest concentration occurring in February (278 events), followed by March (192) and January (170), while comparatively fewer events are recorded during the mid-year months. This pattern underscores the need for anticipatory planning, with intensified preparedness and resource allocation during peak periods, particularly in the first quarter of the year.

This Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) has been developed by the District Health Department, Kozhikode, to provide a comprehensive framework for planning, preparedness, response, and recovery during mass gathering events. Recognizing that effective management extends beyond the health sector, this document emphasizes a multi-sectoral approach, integrating the roles and responsibilities of various departments including local self-governments, police, disaster management authorities, transport services, and community organizations. The SOP outlines district-specific strategies tailored to Kozhikode's unique demographic, geographic, and cultural context. It includes an overview of recurring and seasonal events such as religious festivals, Onam, Christmas, New Year celebrations, and other local gatherings. It further details key contacts, healthcare facilities, ambulance networks, surveillance systems, and emergency response pathways essential for timely action.

In addition, the document provides guidance on risk assessment, capacity building of healthcare personnel, interdepartmental coordination, and implementation of public health interventions. Flexibility is embedded within the framework to allow dynamic planning based on the scale and nature of each event. This SOP aims to strengthen preparedness, ensure rapid response, and safeguard the health and well-being of the population, thereby enabling safe and resilient conduct of mass gatherings in Kozhikode district.

Risk mitigation of Gathering

In the context of Kozhikode district, mass gatherings necessitate a proactive and comprehensive risk mitigation approach to minimize public health risks and ensure the safety of participants. Given the diversity, scale, and frequency of such events, risk mitigation strategies shall be integrated into seven stages of planning and implementation.

Risk Assessment and Categorization

A systematic risk assessment should be conducted before each event to identify potential hazards such as overcrowding, entry and exit bottlenecks, structural and fire risks, extreme weather, poor sanitation, unsafe water, and communicable diseases. The associated health and safety risks, including stampedes, injuries, outbreaks of infectious diseases, heat-related illnesses, and environmental hazards, should be evaluated and prioritized based on likelihood and impact. Based on this, events can be classified as low, moderate, or high risk to guide planning and preparedness.

Environmental and Food Safety Surveillance

Environmental and food safety surveillance shall be rigorously implemented during mass gatherings to prevent public health risks. This shall include regular water quality monitoring through systematic collection and testing of water samples from all drinking water sources at the venue. Adequate chlorination shall be ensured, and residual chlorine levels shall be periodically monitored to maintain safety standards. Food safety surveillance shall involve inspection of all food establishments and temporary stalls before and during the event, verification of valid licenses including D&O permits, and assessment of health cards of food handlers. In addition, food hygiene practices, storage conditions, and waste management at food stalls shall be closely monitored. Measures shall also be taken to prevent accumulation of waste and to control vector breeding.

A district-specific checklist for fairs and festivals already exists in Kozhikode district (Annexure 6). This is used by the field-level staff during the prior visit to the concerned area in relation to fairs and festivals to ensure systematic implementation and effective monitoring of all environmental and food safety measures and to prevent adverse events.

Infection Prevention, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (IPC & WASH)

Appropriate infection prevention and control measures shall be implemented at all mass gathering venues to minimize the risk of disease transmission. Adequate hand hygiene facilities, including hand washing stations with soap and water, shall be provided at strategic locations to promote personal hygiene. Safe drinking water supply shall be ensured through regular monitoring and adequate chlorination. Sanitation facilities, including sufficient and gender-segregated toilets, shall be installed and properly maintained to meet the needs of the gathering. In addition, respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette shall be promoted through public awareness measures, and provisions shall be made for identification and temporary isolation of symptomatic individuals.

Crowd Management and Safety Measures

Effective crowd management strategies shall be implemented in coordination with law enforcement agencies. Measures shall include regulated entry and exit points, crowd flow control, barricading, and clear signage. Adequate lighting and public address systems shall be ensured. Emergency evacuation plans shall be developed and communicated to all stakeholders.

Medical and Emergency Preparedness

On-site medical facilities shall be established based on the risk categorization of the event. These shall include trained healthcare personnel, essential medicines, and emergency equipment. Ambulance services with defined referral linkages to nearby healthcare institutions shall be ensured. Triage and first aid systems shall be operational to manage medical emergencies effectively.

Intersectoral Coordination

Effective coordination among all relevant stakeholders shall be ensured through a clearly defined framework. Departments including Health, Local Self Government, Police, Fire and Rescue Services, Transport, and Disaster Management Authorities shall work in close collaboration. Roles and responsibilities shall be delineated, and coordination meetings shall be conducted at regular intervals.

Emergency Preparedness and Response

Preparedness plans shall be in place to address potential emergencies such as disease outbreaks, heat-related illnesses, accidents, and stampedes. Designated referral facilities shall be identified, and contingency plans shall be developed. Mock drills and simulation exercises shall be conducted to assess readiness and improve response capacity.

Summary of Temporal events of Gathering with timeline

In Kozhikode, a total of 794 gathering events are occurring, with a heavy concentration in the first quarter of the year and a significant decline during the monsoon and mid-year periods.

Command system and system collaboration

District-Level Command System and Interdepartmental Coordination for Mass Gatherings

In light of anticipated mass gatherings and festival-related events in Kozhikode district, a structured District-Level Command System will be activated by the Health Department to ensure coordinated preparedness and effective response. This system, adapted from the existing disaster management framework, will be operational during major events such as religious festivals, Onam, Christmas, New Year celebrations, and other large public gatherings that pose potential public health risks.

The Incident Control Centre (ICC) will function as the central coordinating body for all health-related activities during such events. The ICC will operate under the direct supervision of the District Medical Officer (DMO), Kozhikode, who will maintain continuous coordination with the District Collector, Director of Health Services, and relevant state-level authorities.

The Additional District Medical Officer (ADMO), or a designated senior officer, will serve as the Incident Controller, leading and overseeing all operational components of the response. The ICC will comprise key officials including the Deputy District Medical Officer (Dy. DMO) and Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) Officer. The Dy. DMO will assume the roles of Information and Safety Officer, while the RCH Officer will function as the Liaison Officer, ensuring coordination across departments.

The ICC will be established at a centrally accessible and strategically appropriate location, such as the Government Guest House, West Hill, or another identified site depending on the nature and scale of the event. Upon activation, non-essential routine activities under the District Medical Office will be minimized, allowing full operational focus on mass gathering preparedness and response, while essential health services will continue under designated supervision.

The District Command Centre will serve as the nodal hub for real-time coordination, communication, and decision-making. All relevant departments—including Police, Fire & Rescue Services, Local Self Government Institutions, Transport, and Disaster Management

Authorities—will be integrated into this system. Department heads or their designated representatives will report to the ICC, confirm preparedness measures, and communicate any resource gaps for immediate action.

The Liaison Officer will ensure seamless interdepartmental coordination, facilitating unified and efficient functioning of all operational units. The Information Officer will manage internal and external communications, including situation updates, media briefings, and public information dissemination, supported by medical records personnel and a designated public information desk.

The ICC will issue directions to all sub-systems, including field medical teams, surveillance units, ambulance services, and healthcare facilities, ensuring adequate resource deployment and rapid response mechanisms. This district-level command system will enable a proactive, coordinated, and efficient health response, thereby minimizing risks and safeguarding public health during mass gatherings in Kozhikode district.

Number and split of HR

For mass gathering events, each Medical Aid Post (MAP) will be staffed with essential personnel to ensure effective service delivery. A Medical Officer will lead clinical care, supported by staff nurses for patient management. Paramedical staff, including pharmacists and nursing assistants, will assist in drug dispensing and basic care. Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) will support pre-hospital care and referrals. Each ambulance will be staffed with a driver and an EMT. Detailed HR distribution is provided in the Annexure 5.

Facilities to be arranged

Each Medical Aid Post (MAP) will be equipped to manage common medical emergencies during mass gatherings. This will include emergency care kits, essential drugs, intravenous fluids, oxygen cylinders, and first aid supplies. Basic diagnostic and monitoring equipment such as BP apparatus, pulse oximeter, and glucometer will be ensured. Adequate lighting, waste disposal mechanisms, and communication systems for coordination with the District Control Centre and referral services will also be arranged.

Support Accessories

To ensure smooth functioning of the Medical Aid Posts, necessary support accessories will be arranged. These will include tables and chairs for staff, patient examination beds, stretchers and wheelchairs for patient movement, and privacy screens where feasible. Adequate shelter, drinking water, and basic sanitation facilities will be ensured for both patients and staff. Proper signage will be displayed to enable easy identification and access to the Medical Aid Post.

Ambulance staff pattern

Each ambulance deployed for mass gatherings shall be staffed with a trained driver, nursing staff, and an emergency medical team to provide immediate medical care and ensure safe referral during emergencies.

Evacuation route briefing and Training

An evacuation plan has been prepared for major mass gatherings occurring in the vicinity of Kozhikode beach area, including Beypore Fest. Considering the coastal location and large crowd turnout, specific evacuation routes and procedures have been identified to ensure rapid and safe movement during emergencies. The nearest referral facility has been designated as Government General Hospital, and all evacuation pathways are planned to facilitate timely access to the hospital. The detailed evacuation plan is provided below for implementation by all concerned stakeholders.

Prior to the event, evacuation route briefings will be conducted for all stakeholders, including health personnel, police, fire and rescue services, event organizers, and volunteers. These briefings will include route mapping, crowd flow management, identification of assembly points, ambulance positioning, and roles and responsibilities during evacuation.

Regular mock drills and simulation exercises will be carried out to familiarize all teams with evacuation protocols, communication channels, and coordination mechanisms. Special emphasis will be given to triage at site, prioritization of patient movement, and seamless transfer to ambulances and referral facilities.

Public announcements and signage will also be incorporated to guide the crowd during emergencies. This structured approach to evacuation planning, briefing, and training will ensure preparedness, minimize response time, and enhance coordinated action during any mass casualty event.

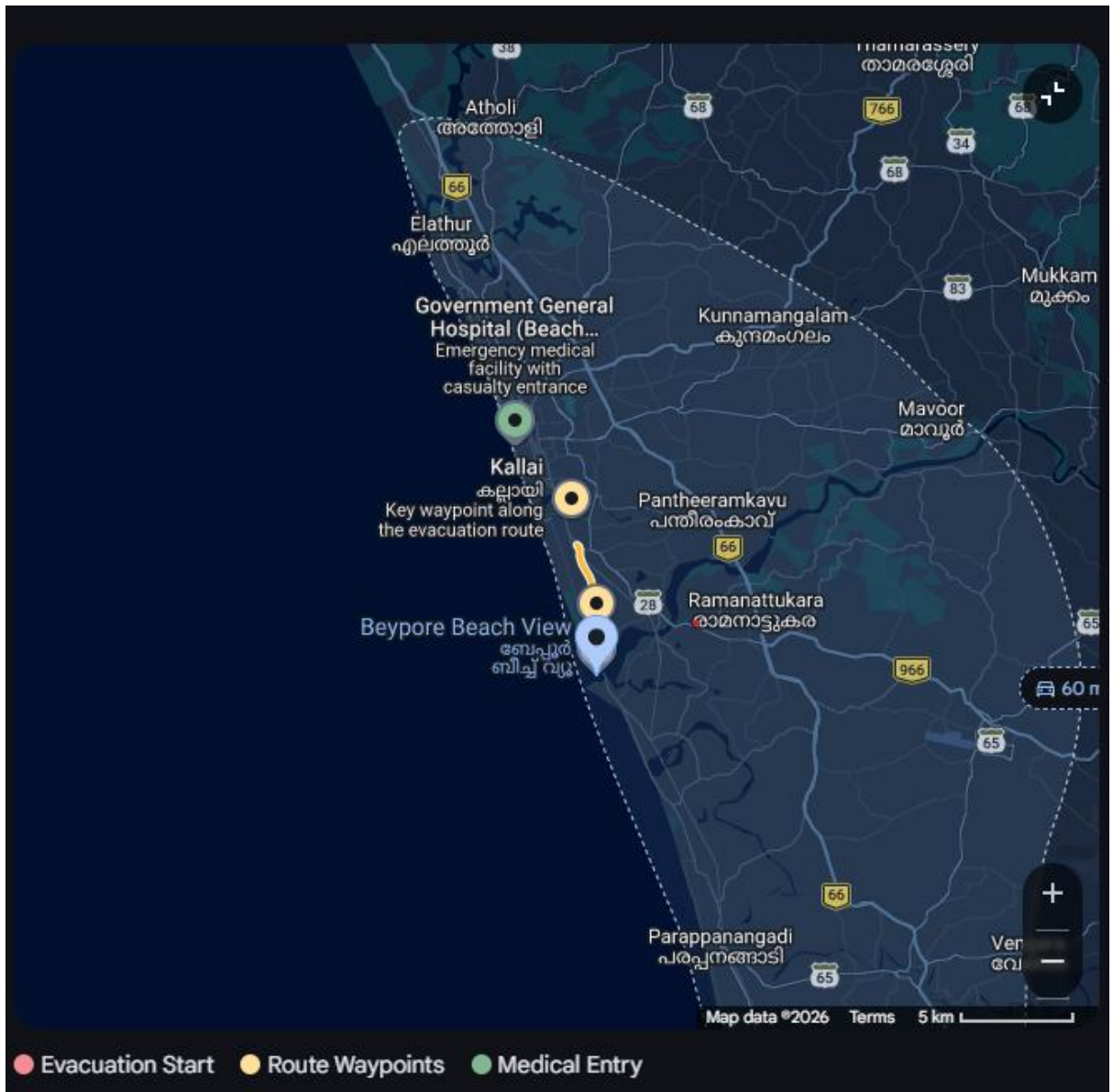
Beypore Beach Exit & Primary Route

- To avoid pedestrian crowds and festival stalls, emergency vehicles utilize a controlled exit strategy:
- Emergency Exit Point: The designated exit is typically via the Beypore Marina Shore Road, bypassing the main pedestrian entrance at the Beypore Beach Floating Bridge area.
- Main Corridor: Vehicles proceed north via the Beypore-Kozhikode Road. During the festival, specific segments of this road, particularly through Meenchanda and Vattakinar, are monitored by traffic police to provide a clear lane for ambulances.
- City Access: The route enters the city coastal area via Customs Road/Beach Road, which connects directly to the medical district near the Kozhikode lighthouse.

Beach Hospital Casualty Entry

- The destination is the Government General Hospital (Beach Hospital), which functions 24/7 as the primary trauma centre for the event.
- Entry Point: The Casualty/Emergency Entrance is located on Red Cross Road.
- Access Detail: For rapid entry, ambulances enter from the Vellayil side, turning onto Red Cross Road. This entrance is distinct from the general outpatient gates and is designed for wheelchair and stretcher accessibility.

Training

An evacuation and medical response plan for mass gathering events ensures safe evacuation, quick medical care, and proper coordination among all teams. Trained volunteers, the Rapid Response Team (RRT), ambulance services, and hospital staff play key roles, along with support from police, fire and rescue, transport, and local administration. Volunteers are trained in basic first aid, crowd management, and identifying triage categories, while RRT members are trained in advanced triage and emergency stabilization. Regular mock drills help all teams practice coordinated response.

A color-coded triage system is used to prioritize patients: Red (immediate, life-threatening), Yellow (delayed but serious), Green (minor injuries), and Black (expectant). During an emergency, patients are first shifted to on-site facilities such as first aid posts or medical aid camps for initial stabilization before being referred to hospitals. Green cases are treated on-site, Yellow cases are stabilized and then referred, and Red cases are transported urgently by ambulance.

At the event site, clearly marked evacuation routes and assembly areas should be established in advance. In case of an emergency, volunteers guide the crowd to safe assembly points where initial triage is performed. Before transferring patients to hospitals, they should be shifted to temporary medical facilities such as first aid posts, medical aid camps, or field stabilization units. These centers should be equipped with basic emergency supplies including oxygen, IV fluids, essential drugs, and stretchers to stabilize patients before referral.

Patient transfer should follow a structured protocol to ensure timely and efficient care. Adequate ambulance services and backup transport options must be arranged, and coordination with police is necessary to ensure fast and unobstructed movement of vehicles.

Hospitals must be prepared by activating a mass casualty alert, setting up a triage area, and organizing staff and resources like ICU beds, operation theatres, and blood bank services. Clear communication systems and coordination between all departments are essential. Overall, proper training, triage, and coordinated action help reduce deaths and ensure effective emergency management during mass gatherings.

Effective communication is essential, with a central control room and real-time coordination between the event site, ambulances, and hospitals. Overall, a well-organized plan with trained volunteers, RRT, and coordinated departments, supported by regular drills and proper triage, helps minimize casualties and ensures an efficient response during mass gatherings.

Hospital Preparedness

During fairs and festivals, there is an increased risk of mass gatherings, injuries, communicable diseases, heat-related illnesses, stampedes, and fire accidents. Hence, enhanced preparedness measures are important. The event Bypore fest is happening at the vicinity of

the General Government Hospital, Kozhikode preparation should be done during the festival season.

Key preparedness activities include:

- ❖ Activation of Festival Emergency Preparedness Plan
- ❖ Strengthening of Casualty and Emergency Departments (24×7 readiness)
- ❖ Ensuring availability of:
 - ❖ Emergency drugs and supplies
 - ❖ Blood and blood products
 - ❖ Functional ICU beds and ventilators
 - ❖ Pre-positioning of ambulances and referral transport systems
 - ❖ Deployment of additional medical and paramedical staff
 - ❖ Establishment of temporary medical camps/first aid posts at event sites
 - ❖ Ensuring infection prevention and control measures

List of Hospitals with Key numbers of Incident commander

For these events, Government General Hospital, Kozhikode, is designated as the primary responding hospital.

- Incident Commander: Dr. Sachin Babu (Medical Superintendent, 94472 76170)
- Deputy Incident Commander: Dr. Anuradha (Deputy Medical Superintendent, 73565 22250)
- The Incident Commander is responsible for activation of the Hospital Incident Response System, coordination with district authorities, and overall emergency management.

Preparation of the protocol of all Hospitals

Government General Hospital, Kozhikode, follows standardised protocols as per its Hospital Disaster Management Plan:

- Mass Casualty Management Protocol with triage (Red, Yellow, Green, Black)
- Patient Reception and Triage Protocol near casualty area
- Emergency Treatment Protocol with designated treatment zones

- Surge Capacity Protocol, including staff call-back and bed expansion
- Evacuation Protocol with pre-identified evacuation sites (ES1–ES6)
- Communication Protocol through HEOC and internal systems

All departments are assigned specific roles under the Hospital Incident Response System to ensure coordinated functioning.

Crisis team at each Hospital on red alert

During major festival event periods, any emergency institution will operate under Red Alert Mode, ensuring a high level of preparedness and rapid response. The hospital activates its Hospital Incident Response System (HIRS), with the Medical Superintendent functioning as the Incident Commander, who oversees overall coordination, decision-making, and communication with district authorities.

The Operations Section manages patient care, including triage and treatment, while the Logistics Section ensures availability of essential supplies, equipment, and transport. The Planning Section monitors bed capacity and implements surge measures, and the Finance Section facilitates emergency procurement and fund management. The Security Section maintains crowd control and regulates movement within the hospital. Under this system, emergency protocols are activated immediately, additional staffs are mobilized through a call-back mechanism, and patient load is continuously monitored. Coordination is maintained with field medical teams, ambulance services, and the District Control Centre to ensure timely referral and effective emergency management.

Base referral Hospital Detail plan

GGH, Kozhikode will function as the Base Referral Hospital for the emergency events during these festivals, receiving and managing all critical and referred cases from event sites. The hospital will provide emergency, ICU, and surgical care, while coordinating with Medical Aid Posts and ambulance services to ensure timely patient transfer.

All patients will be received at the casualty and triaged into Red (emergency), Yellow (urgent), Green (minor), and Black (dead), ensuring priority-based care. Based on triage, patients will be directed to designated treatment areas including resuscitation (Red), observation (Yellow),

minor care (Green), and mortuary (Black). To manage increased patient load, surge capacity measures will be implemented, including staff mobilization through call-back systems, discharge of stable patients, and expansion of bed capacity. Ambulance-based referral from event sites will be coordinated with field teams, and secondary referrals will be arranged if required. The Hospital Emergency Operation Centre (HEOC), located near the casualty, will function as the coordination hub, ensuring real-time communication, monitoring of resources, and effective management of emergencies.

Temporal Dynamic plans based on Mass gathering events

Detail each event

1. Valiyangadi Nercha belongs to Malappuram District.
2. Beypore Fest: The Beypore International Water Festival, described as the country's largest water festival, has propelled Kozhikode to the forefront of adventure water sports in the country. Embracing this huge celebration, the city transforms into a dynamic hub for a variety of water sports activities, gourmet extravaganzas, and lavish arts and music festivals. People can participate in thrilling water sports such as whitewater kayaking, sit-on-top (SOT) kayaking, bamboo rafting, sailing regattas, country boat races, sea kayak racing, angling, and wing foiling. Local competitions such as wooden boat paddling, net casting, and fishing will engage the community, creating a lively scene. A large public event near coastal areas with risks of drowning, injuries, food safety issues, and heat exposure. Coastal rescue teams, emergency medical units, and ambulance services will be strategically deployed. Referral linkages with nearby hospitals will be strengthened.
3. NewYear: Characterized by night-time gatherings and increased road traffic accidents. Emergency departments will be strengthened during night hours with additional staff and ambulance readiness.
4. Onam: Large-scale celebrations with increased travel and food consumption. Risks include road traffic accidents, food poisoning, and minor injuries. Surveillance and emergency care services will be enhanced.
5. Eid-ul-Fitr: Mass congregations in mosques and public places. Risks include crowd-related emergencies, dehydration, and communicable diseases. Medical teams and first aid units will be deployed at key locations.
6. Christmas: Public gatherings and travel-related risks including accidents and minor injuries. Emergency preparedness will focus on trauma care and coordination with law enforcement.

Attach contact coordinators of incident contact Leads

A district-level coordination mechanism will be established with clearly identified contact persons from all relevant sectors:

- District Medical Officer (DMO)
- Incident Commanders of major hospitals - Hospital Superintendent
- Nodal officers for each event - RMO
- Police Department
- Fire & Rescue Services
- Ambulance Services (Government and private) - Ambulances identified in the area.
- Local Self Government Institutions (LSGI)
- Food Safety and Public Health Officials

A consolidated contact directory will be prepared and shared across all stakeholders and displayed at control rooms and hospitals for quick access.

Add Evacuation routes and Base hospital plan

For each event, event-specific evacuation routes will be pre-identified in coordination with police and local authorities. These routes will ensure rapid and unobstructed movement of patients from event sites to designated referral hospitals.

Each event will have a designated Base Referral Hospital, supported by secondary and tertiary hospitals. Evacuation plans will include:

- Clearly marked entry and exit routes
- Dedicated ambulance corridors
- Pre-identified evacuation sites for temporary holding
- Signage and public announcement systems

All severe cases will be transported to base hospitals, where triage and advanced care will be initiated.

Alert mechanism to secondary referrals

A structured alert mechanism will be established to ensure timely referral and load distribution across hospitals. Information flow will occur from:

Medical Aid Posts → Ambulance Services → Base Hospital → Secondary Hospitals

Real-time communication will be maintained through:

- District Control Room
- Hospital Emergency Operation Centres (HEOC)
- Mobile communication (calls, WhatsApp groups)

In case of surge beyond capacity at base hospitals, patients will be diverted to secondary and private hospitals as per pre-defined referral pathways. Continuous updates on bed availability, ICU capacity, and resource status will be maintained to support decision-making.

Mock drills

Mock drills are conducted across public and private healthcare institutions to assess and strengthen health facility preparedness and response capacities. Health facility mock drills are undertaken under simulated emergency scenarios to evaluate institutional readiness with respect to availability and functional status of essential resources required for emergency response.

IHIP Portal-based mock drills were conducted in June 2025 and September 2025 as part of preparedness activities to assess overall system readiness and availability of critical health system components across facilities.

Under the Health Facility Mock Drill, information on the availability and current status of key components—bed strength, human resources, ambulance services, testing facilities, IT interventions, and blood bank services is captured and reported through the Health Facility Mock Drill module of the Integrated Health Information Platform (IHIP) portal. This enables comprehensive assessment of facility-level capacity and resource availability under simulated conditions, reflecting the preparedness status of both public and private healthcare institutions.

SOP of Interventions in Common Possible health hazards

Mass gatherings and festivals in Kozhikode district occur across diverse settings including temple festivals with elephant processions, coastal gatherings, urban fests, music events, and temporary carnivals/amusement setups. These events are often characterized by high crowd density, temporary infrastructure, environmental exposure, and variable access to emergency services.

Recent district experiences, including a temple festival incident in Koyilandy (2025) involving stampede and fatalities triggered by elephant disturbance and fireworks, and overcrowding-related medical consultations during large fest events, highlight the need for structured risk anticipation and preparedness.

The common possible health hazards anticipated during such events include:

- Communicable diseases: Acute febrile illnesses (Leptospirosis), acute respiratory infections/influenza-like illness, and acute diarrhoeal diseases including food-borne illnesses
- Environmental and seasonal hazards: Heat exhaustion and dehydration during summer events; rain-related risks including water contamination and increased exposure to leptospirosis during monsoon period
- Crowd-related and physical injuries: Stampede, crowd crush injuries, and falls or trauma in congested and high-density venues
- Location-specific risks: Drowning risk in beach and waterbody-associated gatherings like Beypore fest and Malabar river rafting fest; delayed emergency access in congested urban areas and narrow pathways
- Medical emergencies: Cardiac events, acute exacerbations of respiratory diseases, seizures, and hypoglycaemic episodes
- Fest / carnival-related risks: Injuries due to amusement rides, temporary structures, mechanical failure, electrical hazards, fireworks, and LPG-based cooking arrangements

- Transport-related risks: Increased road traffic accidents during events and potential railway-related injuries where gatherings extend near railway tracks

Appropriate preventive and response measures shall be implemented as per the following SOP :

- Medical risk assessment shall be conducted for all notified mass gatherings in Kozhikode district through the District Surveillance Unit (DSU) in coordination with Taluk Health Offices.
 - Risk assessment shall consider crowd size, duration, venue characteristics, accessibility, seasonal disease trends, previous event experience, and the nature of the event including temple festivals, fests, carnivals, and events involving temporary structures, electrical/mechanical installations, fireworks, and food stalls.
 - For prolonged or multi-day gatherings, risk of communicable disease transmission shall be specifically assessed, and enhanced surveillance initiated.
- Onsite medical emergency response teams shall be deployed based on risk categorization, and nearby government and identified private hospitals shall be alerted in advance, with preparedness for trauma, burns, electrocution, and other emergency conditions.
 - Medical Aid Posts (MAPs) shall be established with adequate staffing, essential medicines, IV fluids, and oxygen support, along with basic life support and initial management of trauma and burn cases.
 - Ambulance deployment and positioning shall be pre-planned in coordination with 108 services and traffic management authorities, ensuring coverage of high-density areas and major access routes.
 - A mass casualty management plan shall be prepared for each notified event, including:
 - Identification of triage and stabilization areas within the venue
 - Defined patient flow pathways from site to ambulance points
 - Pre-identification of referral hospitals
 - Direction to nearby hospitals to activate hospital preparedness plans, including surge capacity and emergency duty arrangements

- Preparedness for incidents such as fire, structural collapse, mechanical failure, and road traffic accidents
- The Medical Officer in charge of the onsite medical team shall function as the field medical commander, and shall:
 - Maintain continuous communication with control room, ambulance services, and referral hospitals
 - Coordinate resource mobilization and patient referral during emergencies, including multi-casualty situations
- Updated contact details shall be maintained and made available at all medical posts, including:
 - Government and private hospitals
 - Ambulance services (108 and empanelled private ambulances)
 - Primary Health Centres / Family Health Centres
 - Fire & Rescue services for emergency coordination
- All deployed health staff shall be oriented prior to the event, ensuring:
 - Clear understanding of roles and responsibilities
- Familiarity with triage protocols, referral pathways, and communication procedures
- Adherence to emergency reporting mechanisms
- Triage and stabilization areas shall be identified and established within the venue, ensuring:
 - Easy accessibility and adequate space
 - Availability of basic emergency care facilities
 - Segregation of minor and emergency cases
 - Location away from high-risk areas such as stages, electrical installations, food preparation zones, and fire-prone areas
- For locations with limited ambulance access (e.g., congested areas, beach stretches, narrow pathways):
- Stretcher teams and trained volunteers shall be arranged in advance
- Patient transfer points and evacuation routes shall be clearly identified
- Coordination with Police and Fire & Rescue shall be ensured for safe evacuation

- All temporary food stalls and cooking areas using LPG or open flames shall adhere to safety norms, including safe cylinder handling, leak checks, proper hose and regulator use, and availability of fire extinguishers in coordination with local authorities.
- All patients shall undergo triage and stabilization at site prior to referral, as far as feasible.
 - Receiving hospitals shall be informed in advance regarding patient condition and expected arrival.
 - If patient load exceeds the capacity of a hospital, patients shall be diverted to other pre-identified hospitals as per referral plan.
 - Real-time coordination shall be maintained through the control room to avoid overloading of facilities.

Quick summary of temporal events

A total of 794 mass gathering events are conducted annually in Kozhikode district, with a clear seasonal concentration in the first quarter of the year. The highest number of events occurs in February (278 events), followed by March (192 events) and January (170 events), together accounting for the majority of gatherings. This is followed by a sharp decline in the number of events during the rest of the year, with April reporting 60 events, May 13 events, and very minimal occurrences in July (1), August (2), October (4), November (17), and December (57). This distribution highlights the need for intensified preparedness and resource allocation particularly during the January to March period.

In terms of geographic distribution, mass gathering events are conducted across a wide range of Local Self Governments (LSGs) throughout Kozhikode district, reflecting their deep-rooted cultural, religious, and community significance. These events are not limited to specific areas but are observed across rural panchayats, municipalities, and urban settings. Almost all revenue blocks in the district host multiple events, including temple festivals, mosque-related gatherings, church festivals, and community celebrations.

The distribution indicates that mass gatherings are a routine and recurring feature across LSGs, requiring decentralized planning and preparedness at the local level. Each LSG plays a crucial role in organizing, coordinating, and supporting these events in collaboration with

health, police, and other departments. This widespread occurrence highlights the importance of strengthening local-level capacity, ensuring intersectoral coordination, and implementing uniform public health measures across all LSGs to effectively manage risks associated with mass gatherings.

Conclusion

This Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for mass gatherings in Kozhikode district provides a comprehensive, context-specific framework to ensure safe, coordinated, and effective management of large public events. With a total of 794 events occurring annually and a clear seasonal surge during the first quarter, the district requires a proactive and anticipatory approach to planning, resource allocation, and response.

The SOP is tailored to the unique demographic, geographic, and cultural landscape of Kozhikode, where mass gatherings are deeply embedded across all Local Self Governments and span religious, cultural, and community domains. By integrating district-level command systems, Incident Control Centre mechanisms, and clearly defined interdepartmental roles, the protocol strengthens real-time coordination and decision-making across sectors including health, police, local self-governments, and disaster management authorities.

Emphasis on risk assessment, environmental and food safety surveillance, infection prevention, and emergency medical preparedness ensures that potential public health risks are systematically identified and effectively managed. The inclusion of district-specific resources such as mapped event timelines, healthcare facilities, referral linkages, and contact networks further enhances operational readiness and responsiveness.

Overall, this SOP serves as a dynamic and operational guide for Kozhikode district, enabling decentralized implementation at the LSG level while maintaining strong central coordination. Continuous monitoring, periodic review, and capacity building of stakeholders will be essential to sustain preparedness and improve resilience, thereby ensuring the safe and successful conduct of mass gatherings across the district.

Annexure 2 - SOP of medical Hazard

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR MEDICAL HAZARD MANAGEMENT

Mass Gatherings – Festivals & Fairs, Kozhikode District

1.0 Introduction

1.1 Background

Mass gatherings such as festivals and fairs in Kozhikode district pose significant public health risks due to high population density, environmental exposure, and potential for emergencies. A structured medical hazard management system is essential to minimize morbidity and mortality.

1.2 Purpose

This SOP provides standardized procedures for risk assessment, preparedness, response, and recovery of medical hazards during mass gatherings.

2.0 Scope and Applicability

2.1 Scope

This SOP is applicable to all notified:

- Religious festivals and fairs
- Public gatherings and processions
- Events involving large crowd congregation

2.2 Coverage

The SOP addresses:

- Public health risks
- Emergency medical response
- Mass casualty management

3.0 Risk Assessment and Categorization

3.1 Risk Assessment Authority

Medical risk assessment shall be conducted by the **District Surveillance Unit (DSU)** in coordination with Taluk Health Offices.

3.2 Risk Assessment Parameters

Assessment shall be based on:

- Expected crowd size and density
- Duration and timing of event
- Venue characteristics and accessibility
- Seasonal disease trends
- Previous incident history
- Nature of event including temple festivals, coastal events, carnivals, temporary structures, electrical/mechanical installations, fireworks, and food stalls

3.3 Risk Categorization

Events shall be categorized as:

- Low Risk
- Moderate Risk
- High Risk

4.0 Identification of Medical Hazards

4.1 Communicable Diseases

- Acute febrile illnesses
- Acute diarrhoeal diseases
- Respiratory infections

4.2 Environmental Hazards

- Heat exhaustion and dehydration
- Rain-related illnesses including water contamination and leptospirosis

4.3 Injury Risks

- Stampede and crowd crush injuries
- Falls and trauma

4.4 Event-Specific Hazards

- Burns and fireworks-related injuries
- Electrical and mechanical hazards

4.5 Medical Emergencies

- Cardiac events
- Seizures and hypoglycaemic episodes
- Acute exacerbations of respiratory diseases

4.6 Location-Specific Risks

- Drowning (coastal/waterbody events)
- Delayed emergency access in congested areas

4.7 Transport-Related Risks

- Road traffic accidents

5.0 Preparedness Measures

5.1 Establishment of Medical Aid Posts (MAPs)

- MAPs shall be established based on risk categorization
- Each MAP shall be staffed with:
 - Medical Officer (Team Lead)
 - Staff Nurses
 - Paramedical staff

5.2 Equipment and Supplies

MAPs shall be equipped with:

- Essential drugs and consumables
- Intravenous fluids
- Oxygen and Basic Life Support equipment

5.3 Ambulance Deployment

- Ambulances shall be pre-positioned in coordination with 108 services
- Placement shall include:
 - Entry and exit points

- High-density areas and access routes
- Additional ambulances shall be mobilized as required

5.4 Hospital Preparedness

Designated hospitals shall:

- Ensure 24x7 casualty services
- Maintain ICU and ventilator readiness
- Implement surge capacity plans including:
 - Expansion of beds
 - Mobilization of additional staff

5.5 Public Health Measures

- Provision of safe drinking water
- Adequate sanitation facilities
- Waste management systems
- Vector control measures
- Hand hygiene facilities

5.6 Surveillance Mechanism

- Real-time syndromic surveillance shall be implemented
- Monitoring shall include:
 - Fever cases
 - Diarrhoeal diseases
 - Respiratory illnesses
- Rapid Response Teams shall be kept on standby

6.0 Response Mechanism

6.1 Onsite Medical Response

- The Medical Officer shall function as **Field Medical Commander**
- Responsibilities include:
 - Patient triage and stabilization
 - Coordination of referrals
 - Resource management

6.2 Mass Casualty Management

A Mass Casualty Management Plan shall include:

- Designated triage areas
- Defined patient flow pathways
- Identified evacuation routes
- Pre-designated referral hospitals

6.3 Triage Protocol

Patients shall be categorized as:

- Red – Critical
- Yellow – Serious
- Green – Minor
- Black – Deceased

6.4 Referral System

- Predefined referral linkages with:
 - Government hospitals
 - Private hospitals (as required)
- Clear patient transfer protocols shall be established

6.5 Communication and Coordination

- Continuous communication shall be maintained with:
 - District Control Room
 - Ambulance services
 - Referral hospitals

6.6 Special Arrangements for Limited Access Areas

In locations with constrained access such as congested urban areas, narrow pathways, coastal stretches, and temporary event layouts:

- Stretcher teams and trained volunteers shall be pre-positioned for patient movement
- Clearly defined patient transfer points shall be established linking interior zones to ambulance access routes
- Dedicated evacuation pathways shall be identified and kept unobstructed throughout the event
- Coordination shall be ensured with:
 - Police Department for crowd regulation
 - Fire & Rescue Services for emergency evacuation support

7.0 Roles and Responsibilities

7.1 District Medical Officer (DMO)

- Overall supervision and coordination
- Resource allocation and interdepartmental liaison

7.2 District Surveillance Unit (DSU)

- Risk assessment
- Disease surveillance
- Outbreak response

7.3 Medical Officer (MAP)

- Onsite medical management
- Triage, treatment, and referral

7.4 Hospitals

- Emergency care provision
- Surge capacity management

7.5 Health Staff

- Patient care
- Data recording and reporting

8.0 Intersectoral Coordination

Coordination shall be ensured with:

- Police Department – crowd control and access management
- Fire & Rescue Services – emergency response
- Local Self Government Institutions – sanitation and water supply
- District Disaster Management Authority – overall coordination

9.0 Post-Event Actions

9.1 Reporting

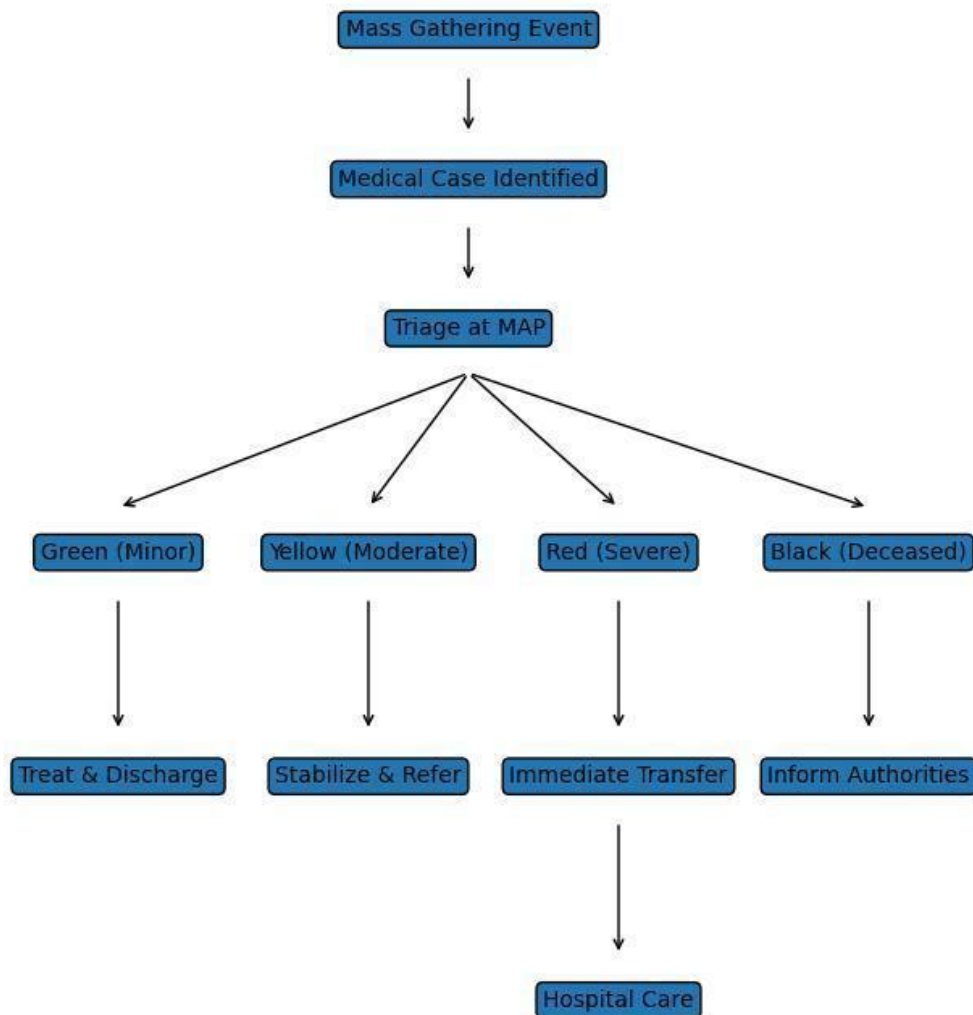
- All medical incidents shall be documented
- Reports shall be submitted to the District Medical Officer

9.2 Review and Evaluation

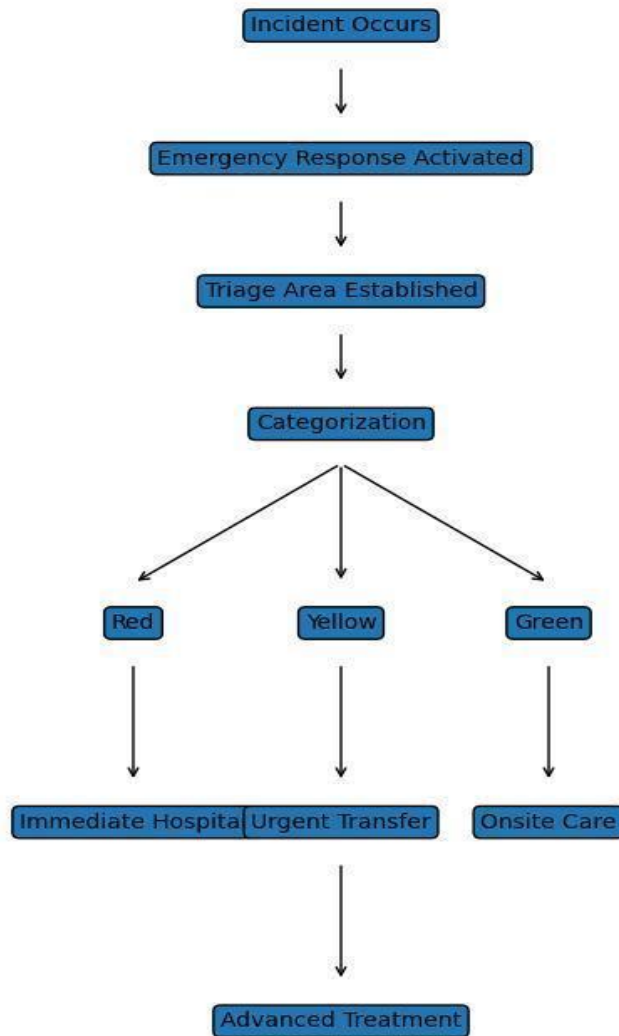
- Post-event debriefing shall be conducted
